Athletic Mission

The purpose of the athletic program is to complement home, church, and school in the development of the whole person. Player's Code of Conduct

The St. Peter athletics program was created to give the students the ability to participate in physical education and to unite the students outside of the classroom. Students that wish to participate in athletics are required to maintain both academic and conduct grades set forth in the school handbook. As part of a team each player is agreeing to follow the player's code of conduct. If the administration deems that a player's behavior goes against the schools code of conduct for players they hold the right to dismiss the player from the team.

- ❖ I will agree to represent St. Peter Catholic School and your family by showing great sportsmanship and positive behavior on and off the field of play.
- ❖ I will agree to live by the Cardinal Virtues in my own behavior / attitude at sporting events.
- ❖ I will agree to work hard on developing your skills, be a team player, play fairly, work hard, and always give 100%.
- ❖ I will remember that participation on an athletic team is the opportunity for you to learn and have fun.
